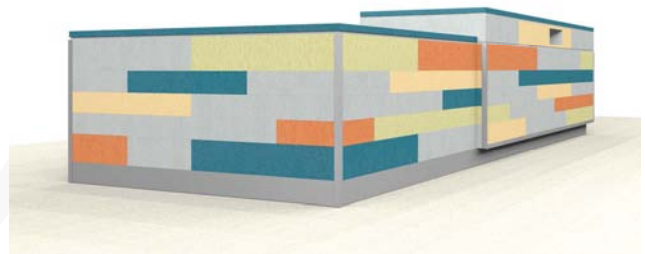
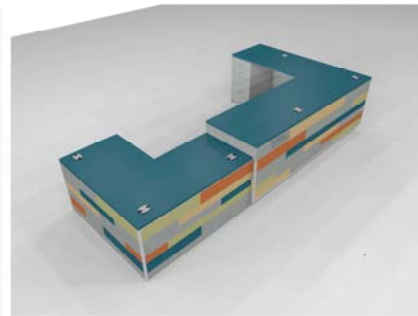
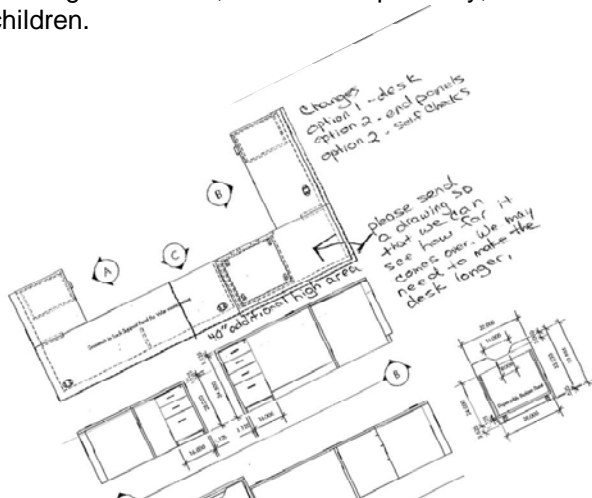
## CHILDREN'S LIBRARY INITIATIVE
