SITUATION:

A medium size school district in the mid west is going through the renovation process for nearly 500 classrooms. The main focus of the renovation will be technology upgrades. The school, the technology value added reseller, and design firm and the dealer approached Vanerum•Stelter with the need to develop a flexible solution to accommodate an interactive board or large monitor as well as something for additional whiteboards.

SOLUTION:

The Vanerum•Stelter's STUdio design team got to work to develop a custom solution. The options for their classroom will accommodate either an interactive SMART board that was fixed, as well as a height adjustable marker board. The solution will meet all of the necessary ADA size requirements, and the thin 11" deep profile is appropriate for renovations and new construction.

RESULT:

The project team was impressed with the quick response from the Vanerum•Stelter team. Detailed drawings and renderings were provided outlining several options and scenarios that will work within classrooms. The project is in the mock up phase for evaluation.

Most importantly, the ability to develop unique solutions has given the dealer the opportunity for incremental revenue, beyond typical furniture solutions. It has also given the team access to the project and decision makers much earlier in the design and construction process. This access has provided an inside track, and uncovered additional opportunities.
